### JBoss Tools - Installation

Create an environment variable called JBOSS\_HOME that points to the JBoss Application Server installation directory, for example: C:\Program Files\Boss\boss-<release>\. In order to run JBoss Application Server from the command line, add the jboss-<release>\bin directory to your path, for example: C:\Program Files\Boss\boss-<release>\bin .

### JBoss Application Server

To install the JBoss Application Server: Download the product from the JBoss web site. Extract the server to a folder of your choice. Once it's been extracted, the folder name should be jboss-4.0.x.

### Installing and Configuring JBoss

JBoss Application Server downloads starting from version 7.0 are hosted on jboss.org. Prior to version 7.0 they are hosted on sourceforge.net. For copyright purposes, a detailed source code change log is stored in the .log file.

Click Window > Preferences, expand JBoss Tools, and then click JBoss Runtime Detection. In the Paths pane, click Download. In the Download Runtimes table select the JBoss EAP version that you want to download and click Next. For JBoss EAP 6.1.x and later, continue to follow the steps given here.
