With a holistic view of humankind, it prays for physical cure as well as spiritual healing, asking for blessing, compassion, restoration, and strength, within the community of others facing illness as well as all Jews, all human beings.

"Mi Shebeirach" is the traditional prayer for the sick. This Hebrew phrase "Mi Shebeirach" begins the prayer, and it translates to "the One who blessed." In this prayer, the person reciting it asks the "One who blessed our ancestors" to bring complete physical and spiritual healing to the one for which the prayer is said.

When there are sick people within our community or family, it is our duty to lift them up in prayer and ask for healing and restoration for them. The traditional Jewish prayer for the ill is known in Hebrew as the "mi shebeirach (מִי־רַבִּישׁ)," and its purpose is to ask for blessing, mercy, and strength for those facing illness.
